SUBJECT: Audit of Commerce IT Security Workforce Issues

We plan to audit the status of the Department's efforts to develop and maintain an effective information technology (IT) security workforce to protect Commerce information systems. As part of our audit, we will review ongoing and planned initiatives the Department and operating units are using to strengthen their workforce and will identify best practices for improving the IT security capabilities of responsible staff.

Our audit will cover a sample of high- and moderate-impact systems at eight operating units, including the Office of the Secretary, and the duties and qualifications of their associated IT security personnel.

To initiate this audit, we will brief the Chief Information Officer (CIO) Council at its February 26, 2009, meeting. We will discuss our objectives, scope, and methodology; our anticipated time frame for conducting the work; and the specific documentation we will need to review. This briefing will serve as our entrance conference.
