We are initiating an audit of National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Fisheries grantees' and subrecipients' use of pandemic relief funds. Our objective is to determine whether federal funds received by Puerto Rico's Department of Natural and Environmental Resources to support its fisheries participants in recovering from the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic and damages caused by several hurricanes were properly disbursed and funds were used for their intended purposes.
