**SUBJECT:** Broadband: A Data Stroll

The U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) Office of Inspector General's (OIG's) Data Analytics team has developed a public data stroll on the broadband program in partnership with U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) OIG's Office of Analytics and Innovation called Broadband: A Data Stroll.
