As part of our fiscal year 2016 audit plan, we are initiating an audit of the planning, design, incremental development, and implementation of the CEDCaP program, infrastructure, and systems that will support the 2020 decennial census.

- determine whether applicable enterprise architectural and system development standards, methodologies, and best practices are being effectively employed on the CEDCaP program and
- (2) assess the adequacy of plans for scalability, reliability, and security throughout the development lifecycle of CEDCaP cloud-based applications.
