Cybersecurity Act of 2015 Department-Wide Security Metrics Assessment

Pursuant to the requirements in the Cybersecurity Act of 2015, Pub. L. No. 114-113, Division N, § 406 (2015), we are initiating an audit of the Department's IT security policies and practices for national security systems and systems that provide access to personally identifiable information (PII). A report of our review is required within 240 days after the enactment of the Act.

The objective of our audit is to examine the IT security policies, procedures, practices, and capabilities as defined in the Act for national security systems and systems that provide access to PII operated by or on behalf of the Department. We will conduct our fieldwork at selected Department and contractor sites.
