Dear Chairs and Ranking Members:

In accordance with 15 U.S.C. § 638b(c), this letter transmits the U.S. Department of Commerce Office of Inspector General's (OIG's) report of the requested data and information regarding cases related to the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) program for fiscal year (FY) 2023.

During FY 2023, OIG did not open any investigations relating to SBIR award recipients. There are three investigative actions opened during previous reporting periods that remain in an open investigative status and two previously reported investigations that were closed during FY 2023.

OIG's estimated FY 2023 expenditures involving SBIR program investigations to date were \$52,672; no funds were recovered or saved as a result of OIG's SBIR-related activities. However, OIG continues to include review of SBIR grant files and coordination with SBIR Program Managers in its ongoing and proactive investigative efforts.
