FISMA Evaluation of NOAA Environmental Satellite Processing Center (NOAA5045)

As part of our work under the Federal Information Security Management Act, we plan to evaluate NESDIS' certification and accreditation (C&A) of NOAA5045.

Our objectives are to determine whether (1) implemented controls adequately protect the system and its information, (2) continuous monitoring is keeping the authorizing official sufficiently informed about the operational status and effectiveness of security controls, and (3) the C&A process produced sufficient information about remaining system vulnerabilities to enable the authorizing official to make a credible, risk-based accreditation decision.
