SUBJECT: Audit of Department's Incident Detection
and Response Capabilities

As part of our fiscal year (FY) 2013 Federal Information Security Management Act of 2002 (FISMA) review, OIG is initiating an audit of the Department and its bureaus' incident detection and response capabilities. Our objective is to determine whether key security measures are in place to adequately monitor networks, detect malicious activities, and handle cyber incidents.

Government agencies, Internet commerce, and vital business sectors are all affected by the rapid increase of cyberattacks. In recent years, several Department bureaus have fallen victim to significant cyber intrusions, which allowed attackers to gain unauthorized access to Department systems and information. In order to protect its systems and information, the Department must have a well-established capability to detect malicious network activities in a timely manner and effectively respond to a cyber incident when it occurs.

We plan to immediately survey all Departmental bureaus about their incident detection and response capabilities. Based on survey results, we will select bureaus for our audit and contact their audit liaisons to set up entrance conferences. We will conduct our field work at selected Department and contractor sites.
